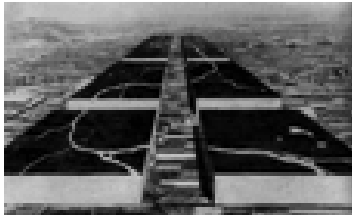
Assignment

- Choose an Utopia from the list.
- Identify the social, economical and ecological challenges the Utopia tried to address.
- Analyse the main components of the Utopia and understand how these tried to address systemic change - change that encompasses not just the technical and material, but regulation, governance structures, values and mindsets.
- Based on the analysis, make an atlas of your own Utopian components and convey how these could lead to large-scale systemic change. **1 x A3 landscape**
- Choose a city around the world and apply your Utopia - Atlas. Illustrate how the city and its residents might benefit from your Utopia. **1 x A3 landscape**

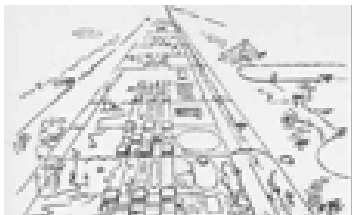

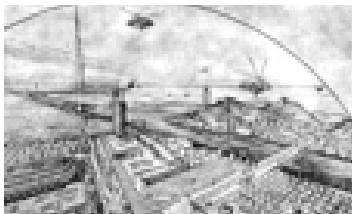

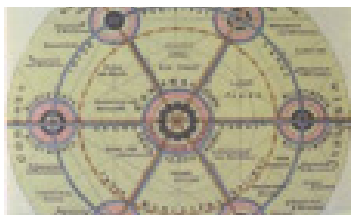

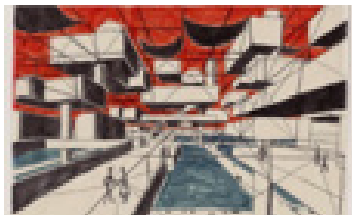

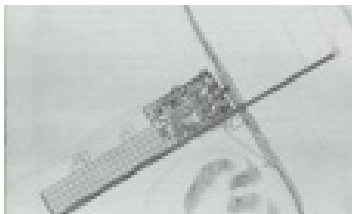
